Brief

Edwin owns and operates the website design and development business, Geoffrey Multimedia. He is also a filmmaker with many TV credits and International awards to his name.

In 2006, Edwin's short film *A Stone Throw* won Best Film at the Theosophical Film Festival (Chennai, India). He has developed feature screenplays with the European Union's premier screenplay development clinic, Arista. *Beware the Stingray* attracted the attention of script consultant, Duncan Thompson (*Japanese Story*, *Black Balloon*) and is currently in development.

Edwin has a Bachelor's Degree in Film & Television and a Diploma in Multimedia. On getting his diploma, he received the *Best Website Design* award from Iinet.

In the late 80s, Edwin was named *WA Young Filmmaker of the Year* two years running and at the Cannes Film Festival (1991) his film *Bunny* was one of three Australian shorts pre-selected for the *Cannes Director's Fortnight*. He wrote the low-budget TV sci-fi *The 100th Monkey* which aired as Channel 7's Friday Late Movie (1998) and he wrote *Indy Nile Investigates* - a cartoon for ABC TV in 2004. In 2005 he directed an episode of *Streetsmartz* for Channel 9 and ABC TV and from 2007-2009 he was commissioned to write, direct and shoot a series of short documentaries about disadvantaged people living under state care in Western Australia.

Aside from running Geoffrey Multimedia and making films, Edwin currently works as a sessional tutor at Curtin University. Since 1995 has tutored and lectured at various WA Universities. He has taught; film and video production, non-linear editing, writing, digital audio production, acting, screenwriting and journalism.

Edwin recently won his Novice Level 2 Ice-skating Certificate and chooses to travel via bicycle.
